What is the Rochester Archery Club, Inc.?

The Rochester Archery Club is a group of people whose interests lay in one or more of the following; bowhunting, conservation, bowfishing, competitive archery, archery instruction, tackle making, and all other forms and parts of archery. Or simply a desire to breathe in good outdoor air and to become better acquainted with fellow archers who have similar interests.

Formed in 1937, the Rochester Archery Club has stimulated interest in archery in general and has produced many competitive champions, many fine bowhunters, and encouraged participation by many archers who shoot purely for the fun of it. We also promote archery through demonstrations and lectures given to scouts and other interested organizations.

What does the Rochester Archery Club offer?

Outdoor shooting ranges. The club owns 43 acres of land in northwest

Rochester along 75[°] Street. We have a practice range with targets at marked distances from 10 to 60 yards. We also have a field range with life-sized animal targets at various unmarked distances over varied terrain to give our bowhunters well-rounded practice for the hunting season.

Business meetings are held once a month (usually on the first Wednesday) where new members & new ideas are always welcome. Refreshments and social hour follow each meeting.

Newsletters. Prior to each meeting newsletters are sent to all members informing them when the meeting will be held. Other archery news of the month as well as club news, equipment for sale or special bulletins are included in the newsletter.

Awards. Successful bowhunters taking deer, bear, or other game animals with bow & arrow are presented with awards at the annual awards banquet

Social Activities. We may have wild game potluck dinners, guest speakers at some meetings. Also, we may have carp shoots, fun shoots, coon shoots, small game hunts, hog roasts. We host 3D shoots several times a year, and an annual awards banquet.

Membership Types - The Rochester Archery Club offers a reduced rate for Youth (under age 18) in an effort to promote archery. Adults can choose Single or Family memberships. Family memberships include spouse and children under 18 years of age.

Members that want to get involved with club activities (help with fund raising activities, or serve as a club officer) can earn "credits" to reduce membership dues. All memberships are based on a calendar year (January through

December). Renewing members are required to pay the full years dues.
